May just be pictures in a book when by a stranger found.


But years from now I'll choose that book from off a dusty shelf,

No memories there of others see to wealth it can't compare.




If actual activity is not your idea of an enjoyable Saturday evening, feel free to relax and vegetate in the Ad Building chapel while watching the movies planned for the night.

No matter what is scheduled for the Saturday night activity, there is almost always something for everyone.











In Rhode Island, "The Breakers" were visited. The students toured the \$30 million summer "cottage" of the Vanderbilt family.





## S.A. CHRISTMAS PARTY




