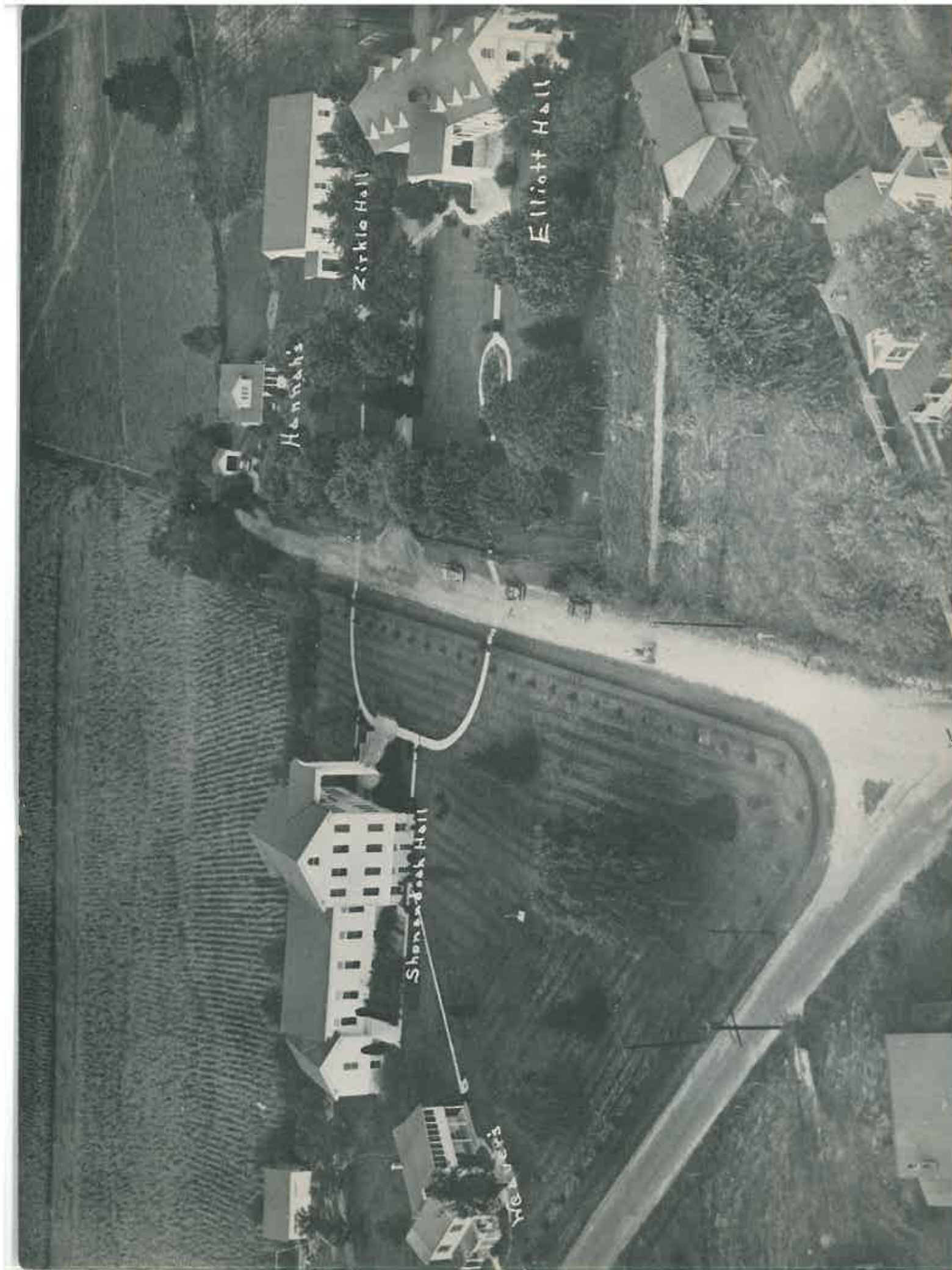

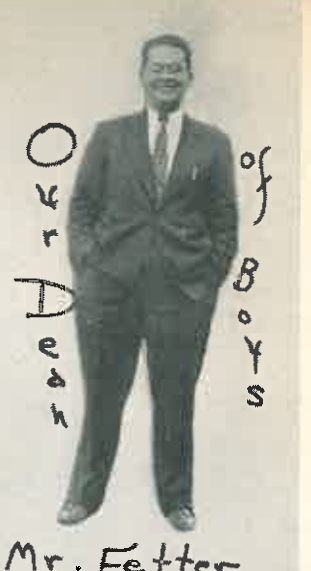

The production of this small paper not only gives its staff many pleasant hours of work, but acquaints others with our school.

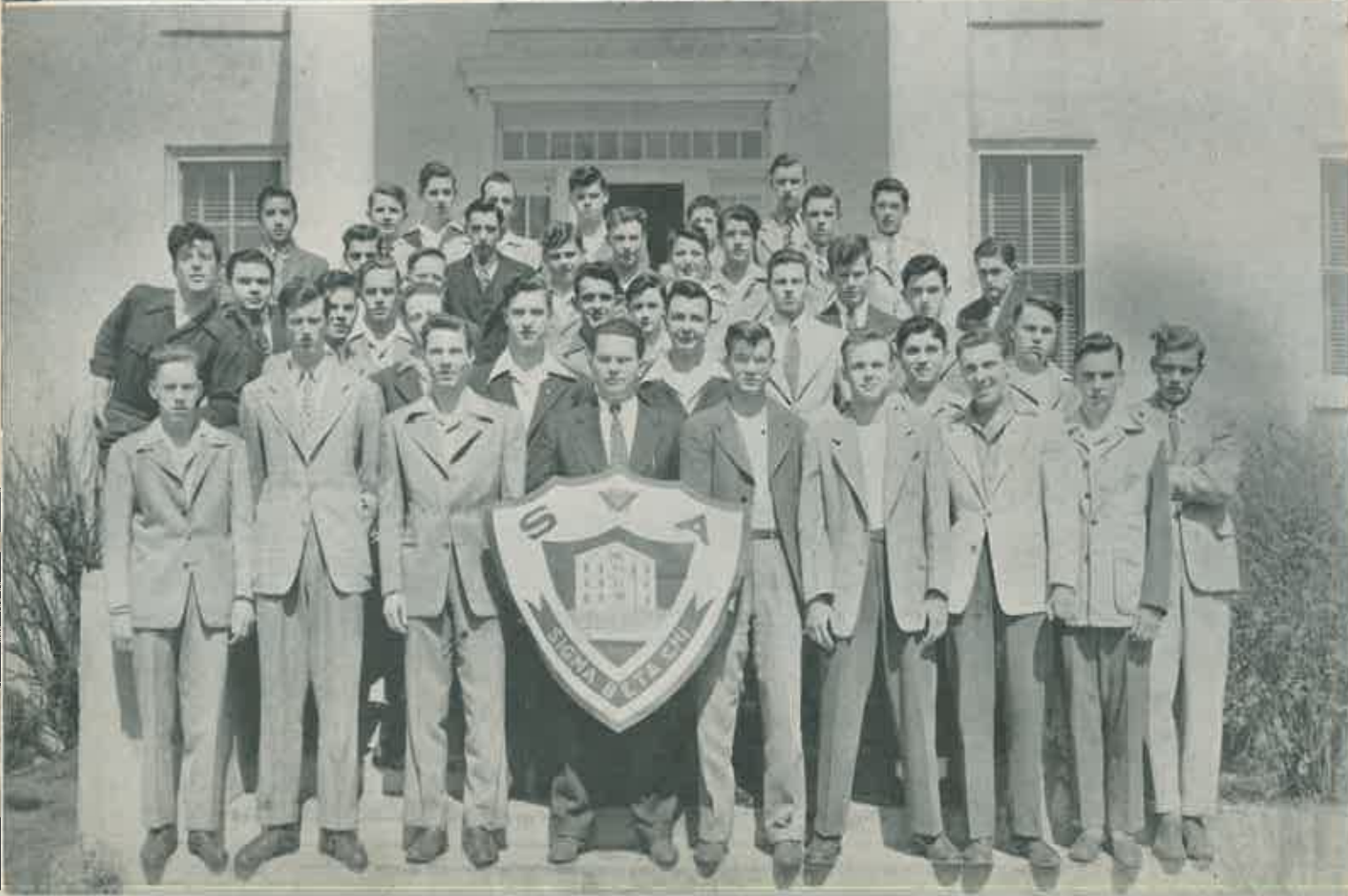
