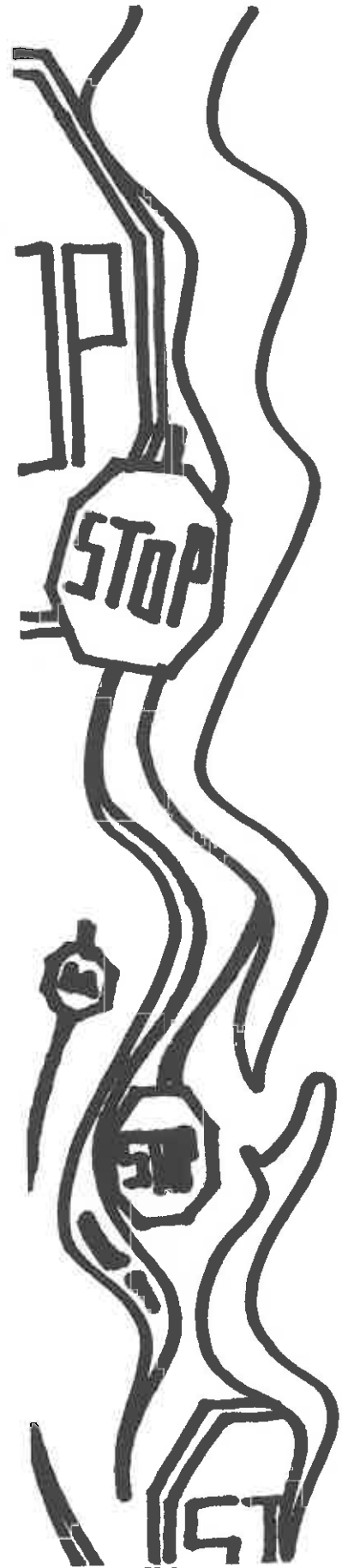

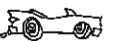

And so we began another hectic SVA school year--arming ourselves with friends, sometimes on our shoulders, to help fight off stress and make this year a journey we will never forget.

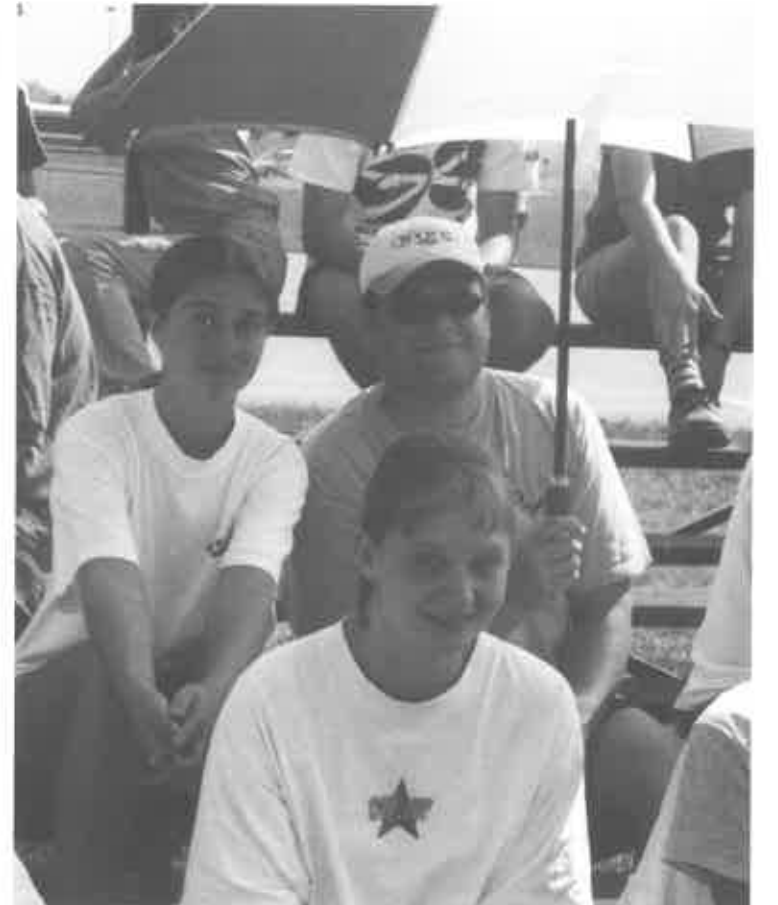

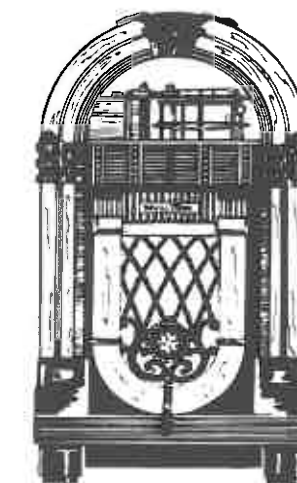




## Valentine's Banquet

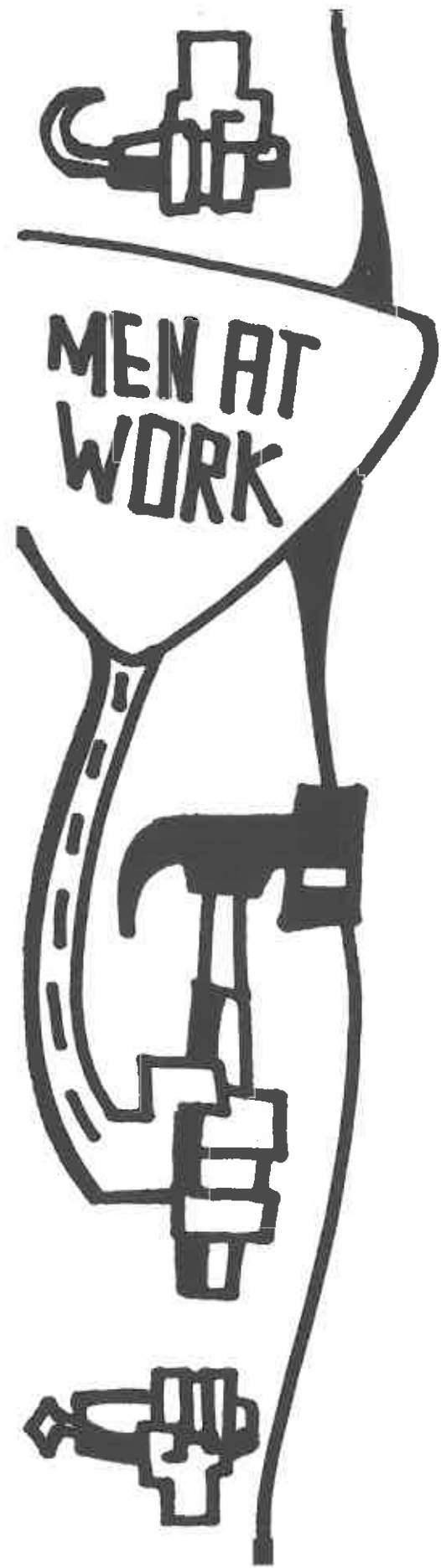

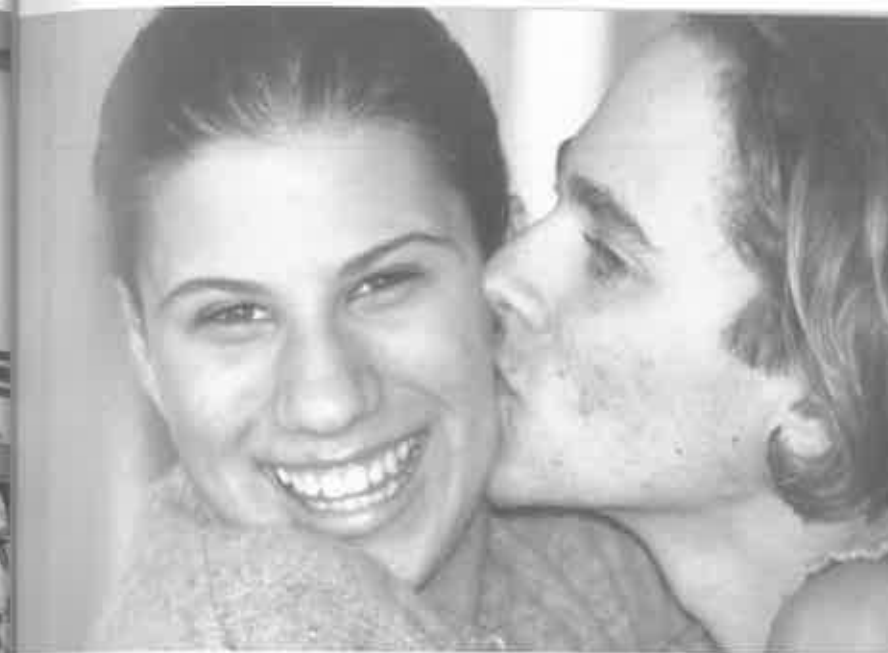

Have you ever seen God? I mean really seen a piece of him. This was the purpose of Bible conference--to give us an opportunity to find God.

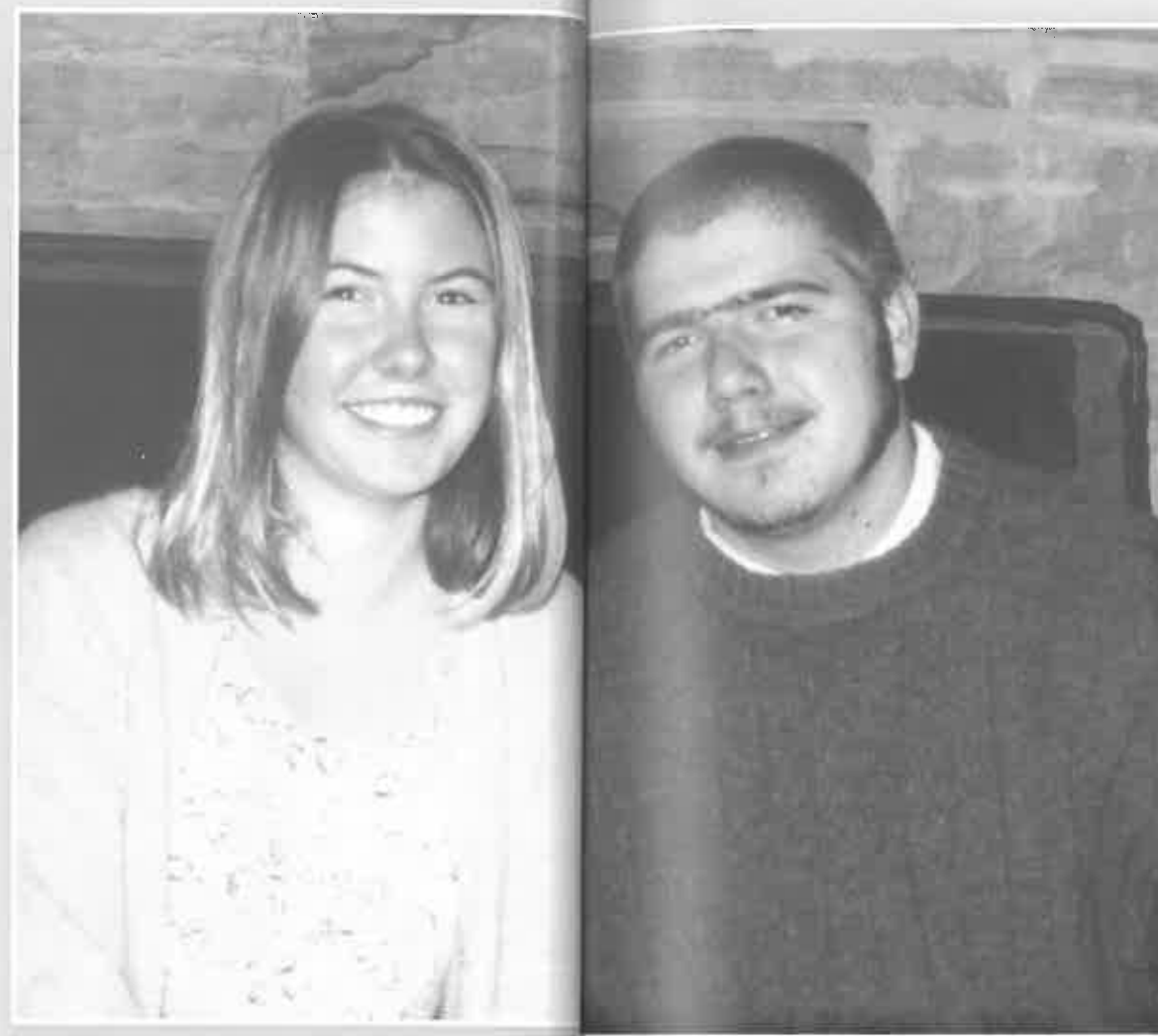

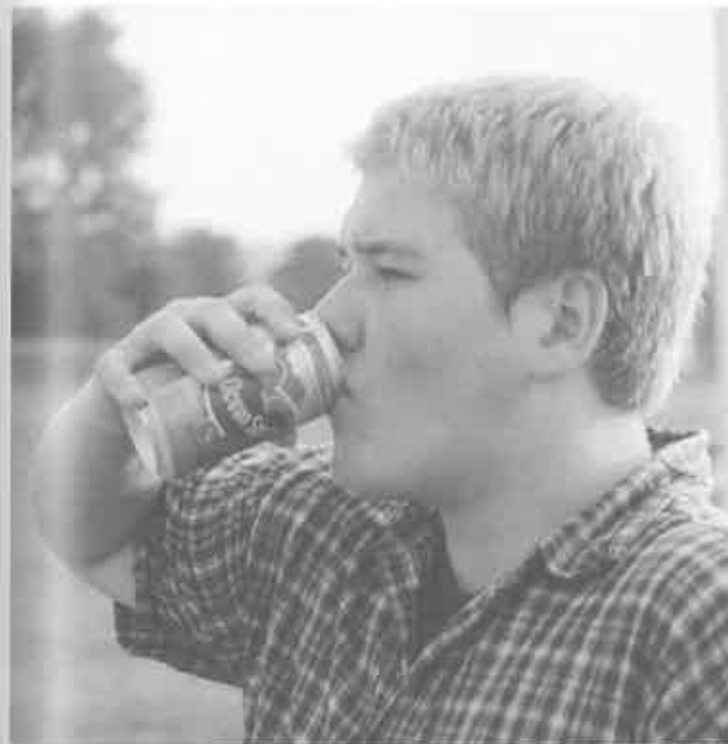
Envision a classful of newly inducted Sophomores falling to their knees and praising God that they're no longer Freshmen. This is what the first week of the Sophomore year is about.
