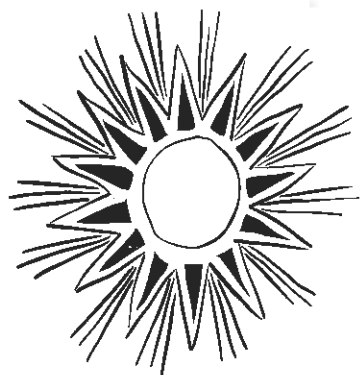

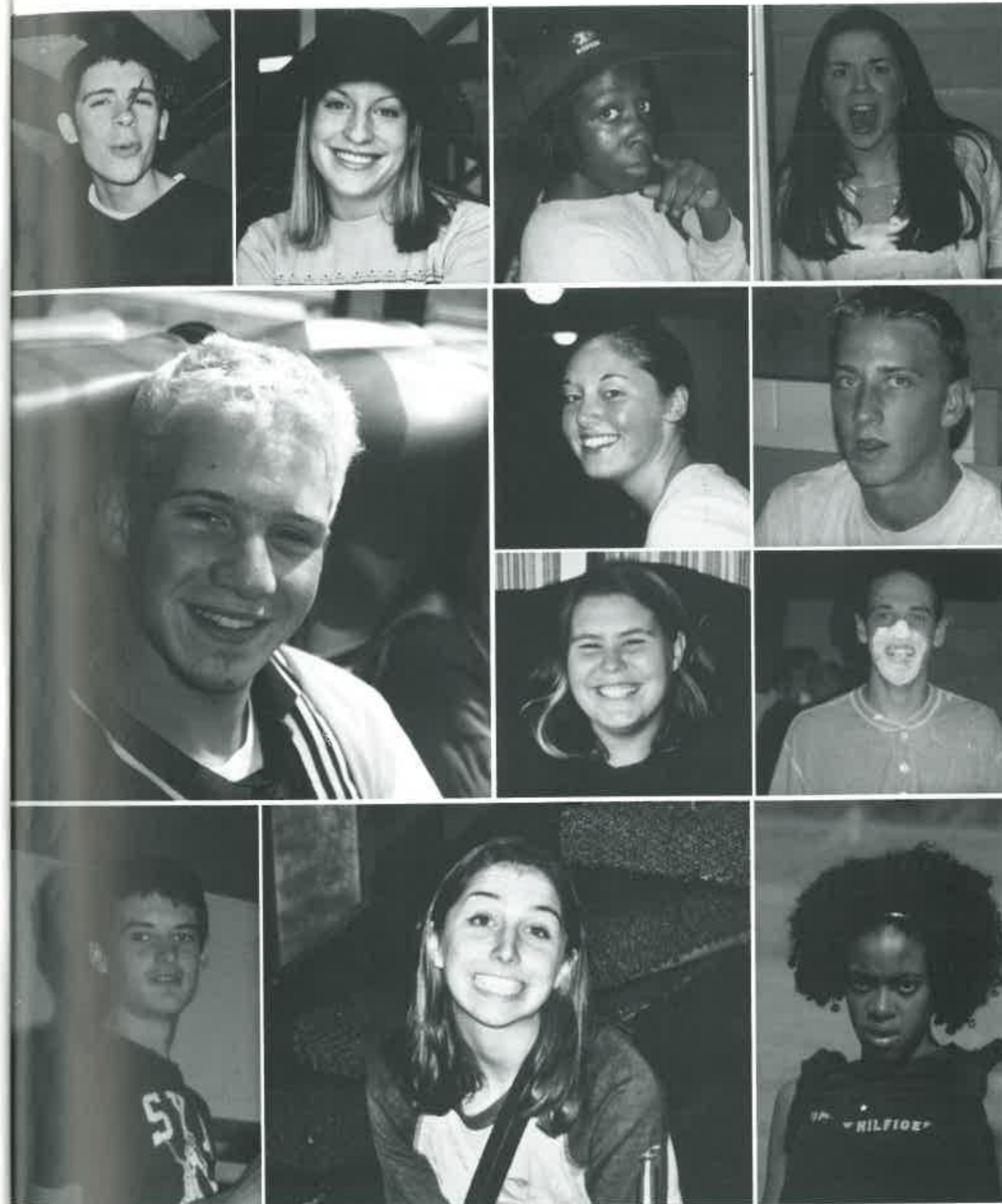
OUR TIME TO SHINE

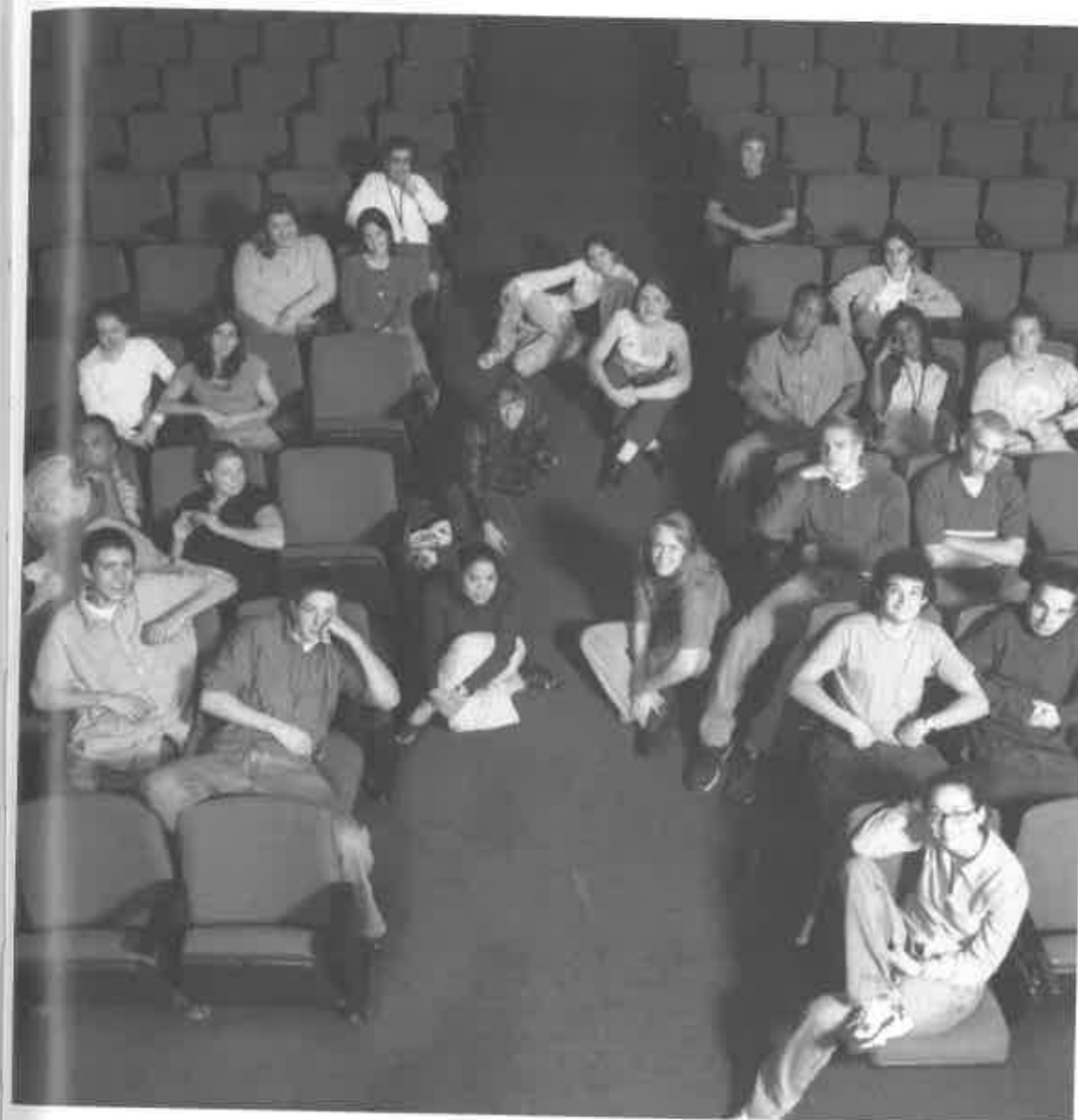
