Pray to the Father for peace, and love.

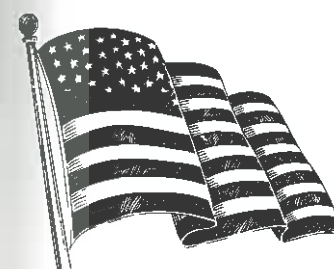

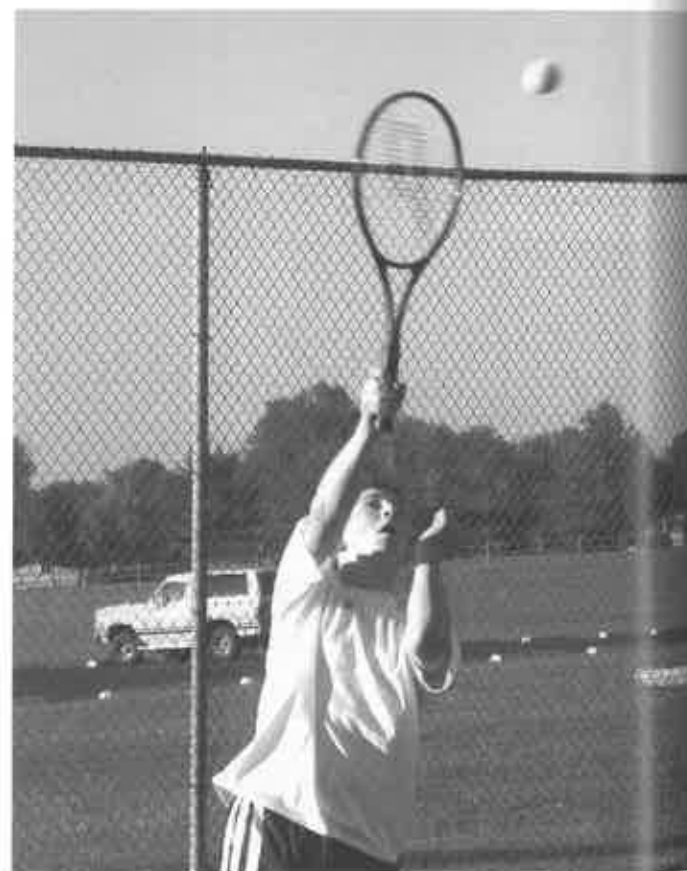

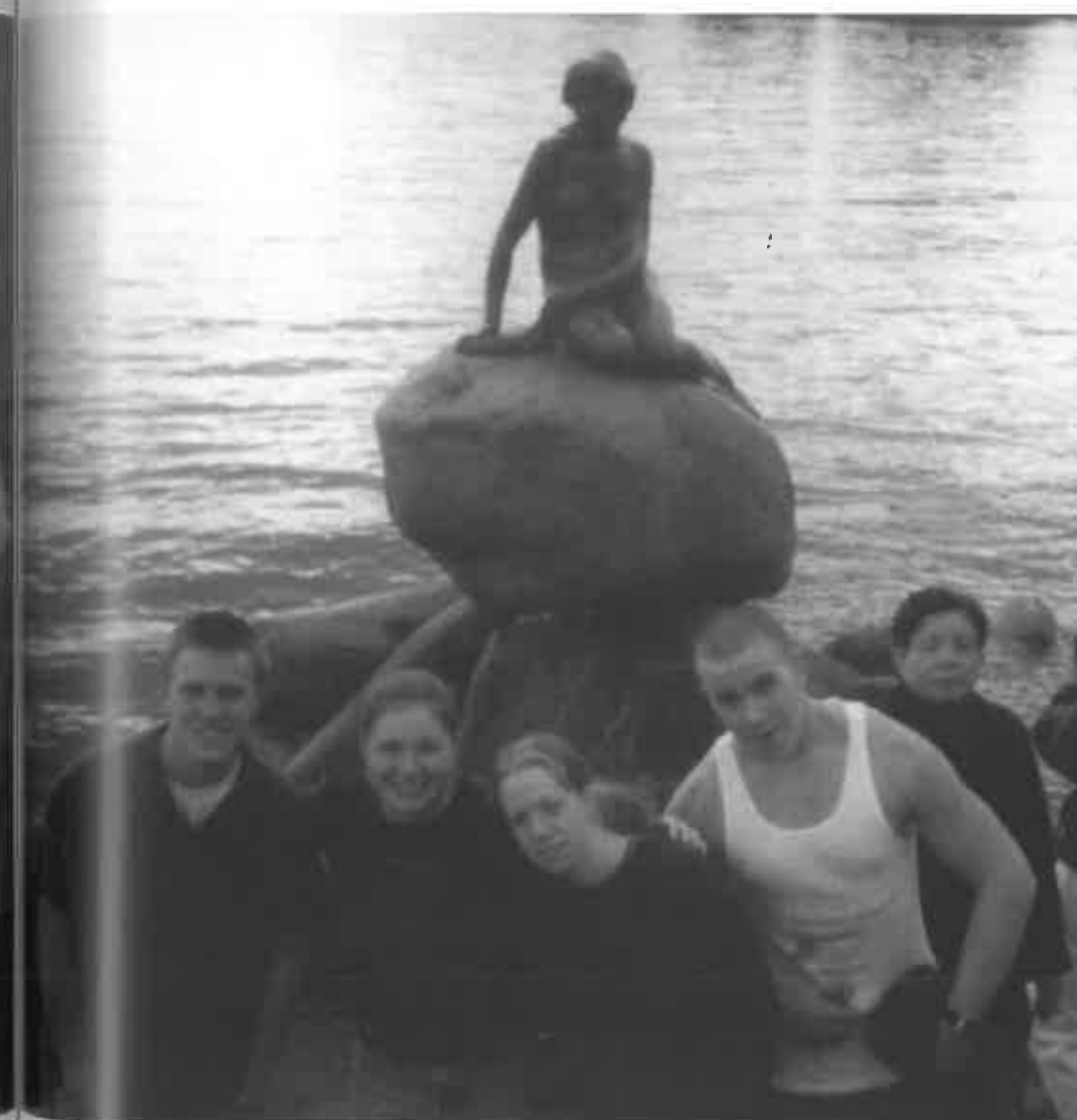
